Choose one and follow the directions. Whether you grow organic or not there's a nutrient program that will suit your needs.


Prevention is key

Genetics: Photo -v- Auto?

Picking genetics can be tricky. First and foremost be sure you know exactly how, what, and why your growing your specific strands. Different strands produce higher yields, higher cannabinoid content, and also more oils. It is also very important to purchase and grow seeds from a reputable breeder.

That being said, there are also different types of seeds to choose from. Regular photo period seeds can produce both male and female plants. Photo feminized seeds are 99% all female plants (there's always a chance that a feminized seed can still be male and/or hermaphrodite). Auto flowering seeds are all feminized plants that don't require any light deprivation to initiate the flowering or budding phase. Advantages of auto-flowers are they can be much easier to grow. They also harvest sooner than photos. The advantages of growing photo period plants will be that they will typically yield more. The ability to control when you switch to the flowering phase gives you the ability to grow the plant larger.

As far as cannabinoid content, THC and CBD levels depend greatly on how the plant is treated during the grow process and the strain genetics. Reputable breeders will provide specifications on cannabinoid content range and dominant terpenes along with grow information.
